The Jack Brewer Foundation presents Rolando Cantu with Global Ambassador Award

Cancun, Mexico - On March 18, 2010, The Jack Brewer Foundation is proud to announce that they will present the 2010 Global Ambassador Award to Rolando Cantu, in recognition of his commitment to youth development through sports, in Mexico and across the globe . Mr. Cantu is being honored with this award in particular for his promotion of youth football in Mexico through his Campamento Rolando Cantu (Rolando Cantu's Kids Camps). The prestigious award will be presented to Mr. Cantu on Thursday, March 18th at Futsal Court in Quintana Roo, Mexico, following a series of youth development programs organized in coordination with the Inter-American Development Bank (IADB).

The Jack Brewer Foundation is also proud to announce its continued partnership with Rolando Cantu and his youth football camps. In addition to the IADB programs, Mr. Cantu will be holding a youth football camp next Saturday, March 20 in Monterrey.

The programs on Thursday, March 18th, are part of an event for the youth in the Leona Vicario community. In conjunction with the IADB, Mr. Cantu and Mr. Brewer will demonstrate how sports and culture serve as a tool for youth development and to highlight their contributions through community service. The goal of this event is to emphasize how sports can help youth to by improving self-esteem, employability and teamwork. Furthermore, athletics promote conflict resolution, violence prevention and social inclusion at the community level. Participants of this celebratory event will visit the community and take part in a series of activities including the inauguration of a sports facility, with a baseball field and futsal (indoor soccer), basketball and volleyball courts; the laying of the foundation stone of the future House of Culture, a ribbon cutting ceremony for a renovated library; a cultural and gastronomic fair; and an artistic presentation of Colombian singer Fonseca.

Rolando Cantu - Biography:

Rolando's full name is Rolando Roel Cantu Chavez. He has won two national championships in the ONEFA (99,02), Mexico's college system with ITESM Campus Monterrey. He also won a world

championship (04) with the Berlin Thunder in the NFLE. He holds the distinction of being the first Mexican born player in the NFL. Mr. Cantu has had nine 9 camps so far throughout the Mexican Republic with 65 active NFL players. Cantu is dedicated to promoting the game in Mexico and South Texas where he attended Mcallen High School, and where his immediate family resides. Mr. Cantu and his wife (Carmen) have a daughter (Mariana) born on September 3, 2004, one day after the Cardinals beat the Broncos in Denver in a NFL preseason game. He is currently the Manager of International Business Ventures for the Arizona Cardinals.
