### **The Jack Brewer Foundation Announces Their New JBF 1 World Initiative**

New York, NY - The Jack Brewer Foundation (JBF) is proud to announce the creation of their latest initiative, JBF 1 World in support of its mission to "Promote and facilitate cultures crossing unexpected boundaries to increase understanding, tolerance and acceptance." In partnership with the Eli Klein Fine Art Gallery located in Soho, the JBF 1 World initiative includes bringing the first group exhibition in China dedicated to the work of black artists.

The Foundation has recently completed a flourishing trip to Malawi, Africa, where they promoted all of JBF's initiatives. Their trip was a major success as they effectively renovated an irrigation system that supplies water to over 2,500 people. JBF has also completed storage of over 4,000 bags of maize for the JBF/JBF Microfinance Program and began construction on a new Orphan Care Center that will provide a home to over 120 orphans. Additionally, they continued to promote education throughout Malawi, providing over 100 students with scholarships to attend secondary schools that they otherwise could not have attended.

From Malawi, Jack Brewer and JBF representatives traveled to Beijing with the Eli Klein Fine Art Gallery where they are currently promoting black artists throughout China as part of the new JBF 1 World project. Upon his return from China, Mr. Brewer will be continuing his work with the Millennium Development Goals (MDG) Awards on September 19th in New York.
